Introduction

Welcome to iHire's **Healthcare Hiring Pulse Report: 2021–2022**, an insider's look at recruitment and employment trends in **14 healthcare industries** throughout the past year.

Like 2020, 2021 was turbulent, with COVID-19 and the “Great Resignation” affecting every industry in some way. However, healthcare hiring remained steady, as iHire's platform saw **9.7 million** total job postings across its healthcare talent communities.

Recruitment is expected to pick up as we move into 2022, but a **worker shortage, feelings of burnout amongst employees**, and general uncertainty still hang over the medical fields. Meanwhile, additional complications are arising due to healthcare employees increasingly leaving their jobs.

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics' **Job Openings and Labor Turnover Summary (JOLTS)**, the healthcare and social assistance industries reported the second largest number of “quits” in November 2021, with 52,000 resignations. Because of the high turnover rates, employers must now not only hire the right talent to fill open positions, but also backfill spots left by departing staff.

To help employers make informed hiring decisions, this iHire report offers a look at healthcare employment trends from the last 12 months, and gives data-driven insights into how the industry performed during one of its toughest years.



iHire's platform promoted 9.7 million total healthcare job postings in 2021. While the largest increases in postings occurred from May through August, the numbers remained steady until they experienced a drop in the final two months of the year.

Healthcare Jobs on iHire by Month




Values indicate the total number of healthcare job postings on iHire per month in 2021.

Not surprisingly, the top hiring industries, many of the most popular healthcare career titles related to nursing. **Registered Nurse (RN)** took the first spot by a large margin, and was the second most sought career title by employers on the entire iHire platform. Furthermore, Nurse Assistant (CNA), Home Health Aide, and Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) were top career titles on iHire, indicating the pressing need for healthcare personnel.

In terms of healthcare job seekers who joined iHire in 2021, candidates most strongly desired Nurse Practitioner (NP) roles, followed by Nurse Assistant (CNA) and Dental Assistant positions.

Values indicate the number of job postings active on iHire as of Jan. 1, 2022, that specify a particular skill or credential.


